Lillard shines in Bucks debut

MILWAUKEE — Damian Lillard scored 39 points in his first game with his new team and the Bucks regrouped after blowing a 19-point lead to open their season by beating the 76ers 118-117 on Thursday night in Milwaukee.

The former Trail Blazers star set a record for the most points by a player in his Bucks debut. Terry Cummings scored 34 points in his first game for the Bucks in 1984. Lillard put the Bucks ahead for good at 105-104 by sinking a 3-pointer with 3:41 remaining. His basket started an 11-0 run that gave Milwaukee a nine-point lead with 2:45 remaining.

“He had the hot hand,” Giannis Antetokounmpo said. “You’ve just got to keep on feeding him. What works, you’ve got to keep going to what works.”

Antetokounmpo added 23 points and 13 rebounds while shooting 10 of 22 from the floor to leap past Kareem Abdul-Jabbar and become the franchise’s career leader in baskets.

Tyrese Maxey scored 31, Kelly Oubre Jr. had 27 and Joel Embiid 24 for the 76ers. — AP

NFL: Bills hold off Buccaneers

Josh Allen threw two touchdown passes and ran for another — shrugging off an aggravating injury to his throwing shoulder — and the Bills hung on to beat the Buccaneers 24-18 on Thursday night in Orchard Park, N.Y. Allen finished with 324 yards on 31-of-40 passing.

The game ended when quarterback **Baker Mayfield’s** Hail Mary attempt from his own 45 fell between several players in the end zone. The Buccaneers have lost three straight and four of five since opening 2-0.

● Dolphins wide receiver **Tyreek Hill** told reporters he is ready to play in Sunday’s game against the Patriots. Hill had missed Wednesday’s practice with a hip injury.

NBA: Lakers rally to defeat Suns

Anthony Davis had 30 points and 13 rebounds, **LeBron James** scored 10 of his 21 points while playing the entire fourth quarter, and the Lakers blew past Phoenix in the final minutes for a 100-95 victory over the short-handed Suns in Los Angeles.

NHL: Penguins end Avs’ road win streak

Reilly Smith scored twice, **Tristan Jarry** stopped 30 shots and the Penguins ended Colorado’s NHL-record road winning streak at 15 straight games with a decisive 4-0 win in Pittsburgh.

● In Boston, **Mason McTavish** scored on a two-on-one break with 2:52 remaining in overtime to give the Ducks a 4-3 victory and hand the Bruins their first loss of the season.

● In Raleigh, N.C., **Martin Necas** scored his second goal of the game with 9.7 seconds left in overtime, and the Hurricanes beat the Kraken 3-2 to snap a three-game skid.

● In Montreal, **Cole Caufield** scored with 43 seconds left in overtime and the Canadians rallied to beat the Blue Jackets 4-3.

GOLF: Jamieson, Hillier tied for lead

Scott Jamieson and **Daniel Hillier** shared the clubhouse lead after shooting 7-under 65s in the first round of the Qatar Masters in Doha on before play was suspended because of lightning.

● In Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, **Jasmine Suwannapura** took a first round lead with a 9-under 63 at the LPGA’s Maybank Championship.
