Devils can't claw their way back against Panthers

A late Devils rally was not enough as Sam Reinhart moved up to the top line and scored two goals and the defending Eastern Conference champion Panthers sent New Jersey to a 4-3 loss on Monday night at Prudential Center.

Carter Verhaeghe and Niko Mikkola also scored goals and Matthew Tkachuk had two assists for the Panthers, who had opened the season with losses at Minnesota and Winnipeg.

Sergei Bobrovsky carried a 3-0 shutout into the third period that was extended to 4-0 on Reinhart's second goal, but saw Erik Haua, Michael McLeod and Jesper Bratt tally to get the Devils within a goal with 2:23 to play. The 35-year-old who has started all three games this season finished with 33 saves.

Vitek Vaneczek finished with 25 saves despite spending the final 4:14 on the bench as the Devils played with an extra skater.

NFL: Cowboys sneak past Chargers

Dak Prescott threw for 272 yards and a touchdown, and the Cowboys rebounded from a rout a week ago, beating the Chargers, 20-17, Monday night in Inglewood, Calif.

Los Angeles tied it at 17 with 7:11 remaining when **Gerald Everett** caught a 1-yard touchdown pass from **Justin Herbert**.

Brandon Aubrey made two field goals, including a 39-yarder with 2:19 remaining, to give the Cowboys the lead.

The Chargers had one last chance to send it into overtime, but **Stephon Gilmore** picked off Herbert at the LA 33-yard line with 1:22 remaining to seal the victory. On the play immediately before the pick, Herbert was sacked by **Micah Parsons** for an 8-yard loss.

● Bills running back **Damien Harris** was released from the hospital on Monday, a day after hurting his neck while being tackled in the second quarter of Buffalo's win over the Giants.

● Colts owner **Jim Irsay** said rookie quarterback **Anthony Richardson** is "probably" going to miss the remainder of the regular season after suffering an AC joint sprain to his throwing shoulder in a Week 5 win over the Titans, according to ESPN. The Colts have yet to determine whether the 21-year-old will undergo surgery.

● Bears quarterback **Justin Fields** will likely miss at least one game because of a dislocated right thumb.

● The Rams will be without leading running back **Kyren Williams** when they host the Steelers on Sunday, ESPN reported. In other Rams news, starting cornerback **Derion Kendrick** was arrested early Monday morning, hours after a win over the Cardinals, on a felony charge of carrying a concealed weapon after a traffic stop in Hollywood. Marijuana was also found in his car.

ETC.: Attack in Brussels halts match

A European Championship qualifier soccer match between host Belgium and Sweden was suspended at halftime Monday after two Swedes were killed in what UEFA officials referred to as "a suspected terrorist attack" in central Brussels before kickoff.
